

## Joe Burrow, president, Joe Burrow Foundation

Joe, quarterback for the Cincinnati Bengals, was born in Ames, Iowa, and is the son of Robin and Jim Burrow. In his first year at LSU, Burrow was named the starting quarterback as a redshirt junior in 2018. He was named SEC Offensive Player of the Week twice during his tenure at LSU. On December 14, 2019, Joe Burrow was selected as the 85th winner of the Heisman Memorial Trophy, an annual award for the most outstanding player in college football. Joe was one of 58 players invited to the 2020 NFL Draft where he was selected first overall by the Cincinnati Bengals. In 2021, he led the Bengals to Superbowl LVI.

Jimmy Burrow, vice president of the Joe Burrow Foundation, is a former defensive back in the National Football League (NFL) and the Canadian Football League (CFL). He is a retired college football coach and father of Heisman Trophy winner and Cincinnati Bengals quarterback, Joe Burrow. Jimmy played college football at the University of Nebraska — Lincoln. His last coaching position was as defensive coordinator for Ohio University from 2005 – 2019. Jimmy timed his retirement from coaching to coincide with the final college football season of his son, Joe Burrow, who played at LSU in 2018 – 2019 and 2019 – 2020.
